

Marshfield Community Centre
Association Pricing policy from 1
September 2021

- 1 Reserves are not used to subsidise ongoing costs. We set annual budgets so that, on average, rental income and income from fundraising activities cover the cost of running the Community Centre.
- 2 We aim for a fair pricing structure, treating all users consistently.
- 3 However we wish to support use by those local clubs that are willing and able to provide a substantial contribution to the running of the Community Centre. We will therefore offer significantly lower rates for such groups.
- 4 We wish to maximise usage of Community Centre facilities. Lower rates therefore apply for less popular periods in the week.
- 5 All rates and charges are reviewed each 1 January. Starting September 1st 2021.

Pricing for pre-booked sessions

- 6 From 1 September 2021 the standard rate for the small hall is £20.00 an hour and the standard rate for the large hall is £30.00 an hour.
- 7 Off-peak rates apply before 6pm on Monday to Sunday. From 1 September 2021 the off-peak rate for the small hall is £15.00 an hour and the off-peak rate for the large hall is £20.00 an hour.
8. Setting up time is chargeable.
- 9 There is a charge for clearing-up time, and all clearing-up is completed by a time agreed with the Bookings Secretary.
10. Call out charge required for evening events due to noise restriction in area and ensuring the centre is closed of £100.
- 11 All - affiliates (**Friends of the CC**) are entitled to a discount of 50% on rentals and
 - Must agree and sign a membership form -(authorised by the community centre only based on regular bookings)
 - pays the affiliation fee of £50 a year on 1 September each year
 - allowed to attend all General Committee meeting
 - Will be encouraged to offer support of work carried out on behalf of the General Committee (for example hall management, fundraising, tidying, decorating, other general maintenance).
 - Must adhere to all special conditions required for hiring of the halls and risk assessments.
- 12 If an organisation other than a friend runs an event where all net proceeds are to be donated or used for charitable purposes then, at the General Committee's discretion, off-peak rates apply at all times for that event.
